Growth Group Discussion Guide

"Growing Upward, Inward, Outward, and Forward"

Scripture: Daniel 7

<u>Sermon Summary – The main ideas found in this week's message:</u>

- Daniel 7 begins the prophetic portion of Daniel.
- It is crucial to understand the differences between narrative literature and apocalyptic literature when reading the second half of Daniel.
- Daniel 7 tells of a dream/vision that Daniel had about three kingdoms: the kingdoms of this world, Satan's kingdom, and the Kingdom of God.
- Daniel 7 parallels Daniel 2.
- Daniel 7 takes place in 553 BC (before chapters 5-6).
- The first beast represents Babylon and Nebuchadnezzar.
- The second beast represents the Medo-Persian empire.
- The third beast represents Greece.
- The fourth beast represents the Roman empire.
- The little horn of the fourth beast represents the antichrist.
- Daniel 7 explains how God will conquer Satan and God's kingdom will reign forever.
- The theme of Daniel continues: IN SPITE OF APPEARANCES, GOD IS IN CONTROL!

- **12.** How does this vision make you feel?
- **13.** What does this chapter tell us the future holds for followers of Jesus?
- **14.** How should we conduct ourselves in the midst of this?
- **15.** What will be helpful for us to remember as trouble heads our way?
- **16.** How can you remind yourself daily that you are in the midst of a cosmic struggle?
